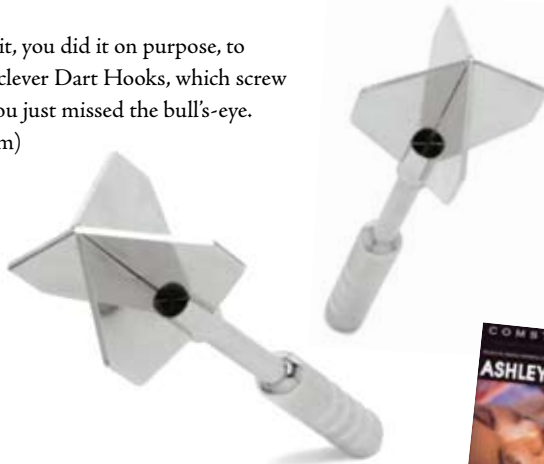
### Puzzlingly Compact
